

Acupuncture with Homeopathy, Hypnotherapy, and Colors

Acupuncture has been practiced and developed by different physicians in different countries for more than 5000 years. Therefore, there are so many different schools that have developed their own techniques and methods of diagnoses. Even within various schools of acupuncture there are subdivisions within which acupuncturists have altered, revised, and tweaked what was taught by their own masters.

Today, acupuncture is predominantly a medical discipline practiced by physicians and licensed healthcare professionals around the globe. In fact, it may be true that on any given day, more people are treated with one or another form of acupuncture than by any other medical strategy.

Most certainly, 21st century research has affected acupuncture diagnosis and treatment. Neurologists, endocrinologists, cardiologists, psychologists, physicists, cellular biologists, and others have influenced 21st century acupuncture as a result of their recent discoveries.

Elsewhere in this section, I have provided some information about forms of acupuncture I use based upon my experience and the feedback patients have provided about their successful outcomes. Well, I have now added three additional forms of acupuncture to my practice: Acupuncture employing the use of focused colored light upon acupuncture points instead of inserting needles (you see light is composed of vibrational frequencies and colors can be used to transmit their own particular vibrational frequencies into acupuncture points much like traditional needles do); acupuncture using dilute homeopathic remedies mixed in water and swabbed on acupuncture sites where the remedy is readily taken up by the body and transmitted via the meridian system; needleless acupuncture as described here and elsewhere in this website that is employed along with hypnotherapy. All of these have proven to be very powerful strategies. One or another of these techniques may be chosen depending upon the reasons you have come to see me, the length of time you have had those symptoms or conditions (acute or chronic), my own assessment based upon both Western medical tests and scans as well as traditional forms of Oriental diagnosis, and the extent to which emotions and similar mind/body issues appear to contribute to your complaints.

As a result of my continuing efforts to research recent discoveries in medicine and science, I offer you breakthrough techniques as they are proven effective. These acupuncture treatments may appear a bit different than those about which you have read before. As medicine continues to evolve, so do traditional medical systems like acupuncture. Today, you have many options, and that means I have more and more options to choose to directly and effectively treat you.
